Tribal Opiod Response

• MAT - Provide opioid misuse prevention, treatment, and recovery support services for the purposes of addressing the opioid abuse and overdose crisis

Youth and Family Trees

- An integrated, wraparound system of care to expand comprehensive treatment, early intervention, and recovery support services for youth (12-18), transitional aged youth (16-25), their families/primary caregivers with substance use disorders (SUD) and/or co-occurring mental health disorders
- SUDs early intervention and prevention; increased community participation, strong collaborative working relationships and formalized agreements among agencies

Native Connections

- Will increase access to culturally-appropriate substance abuse and suicide prevention programming
- Will provide mental health services for age 10-24 American Indian/Alaska Native youth and young people living in Siskiyou County especially those youth residing on QVIR
- Will increase community engagement and strengthening service delivery
